Dear neighbors in our Tucson community,

I am Barbara Eiswerth, founder of the **Iskash*taa Refugee Harvesting Network** and I'd like to take a few moments to tell you about this non-profit organization and how you can help a community of African refugees in Tucson.



Initial involvement

I have been volunteering with a community of African refugees, the Somali Bantu in particular, who began arriving in Tucson in 2003. I began working with refugee teens in neighborhood after school programs. The projects taught youth about local foods. We identified, mapped, harvested, and redistributed backyard fruit and vegetables from neighborhood trees and local farms. We now harvest 20,000 pounds of food each year. Our new neighbor - Somali Bantu

The 1991 collapse of the Somali government and its subsequent violence caused many to flee

their homes. Escaping on foot to Kenya, the Somali Bantu were placed in refugee camps, some for over 13 years. Before the war in Somalia in the early 1990's, they were successful farmers along fertile river valleys in southern Somalia. Unfortunately, they became victims of war and persecution, often due to their ethnicity. Finally, the Bantu have found a peaceful home in the U.S. However, their life here remains difficult.

Helping Somali Bantu refugees

African refugees who have been resettled in Tucson face unique challenges in adjusting to their new urban lives. While thankful for the opportunity they have been given here in Tucson, the hardships they face on a daily basis are unimaginable. Harvesting excess fruits and vegetables helps feed the families and teach them new life skills. As our interaction with this population has grown, so too, has our desire to help them. Iskash*taa's goal is to assist the refugees in a wide variety of activities to foster their economic independence as quickly as possible!

This wonderful community is still in desperate need of your help.
